## DAY 1 Thursday, November 6: Depart for Italy

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport for our United Airlines overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Complimentary dinner (D), breakfast (B), and beverages will be served on board the transatlantic flight.

## DAY 2 Friday, November 7: Arrive in Rome | Assisi

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tour Manager upon exiting Customs. Board a comfortable private touring bus and soon we will be on our way to Assisi. Upon arrival, celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the saint died. You will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. Check-in at our hotel in Assisi and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (D)

# DAY 3 <u>Saturday, November 8: Sites of St. Francis & St. Clare</u> Early morning, walk to the Basilica of St. Francis to celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Francis. Return to our hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, our local

guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto. Continue to the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. View her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Continue to visit the Church of St. Mary Major and Tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Independent lunch. After lunch, we'll hike or take taxis to Eremo delle Carceri, a hermitage complex on the slopes of Mt. Subasio. The core of the hermitage is the actual rock cave where Francis would often withdraw for prayer and contemplation. See St. Francis's cave and the original oratory, as well as the oak tree near a stone bridge where St. Francis preached his sermon to the birds Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi. (B,D)

DAY 4 <u>Sunday, November 9: Siena</u> Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave on our full-day excursion to Siena. Upon arrival we'll walk in the footsteps of St. Catherine in Siena, who lived from 1347 to 1380 as a lay affiliate of the Dominican Order. St. Catherine is known for her intellect and mystical visions of Christ. Celebrate Mass and visit the Basilica of St. Dominic, just up the hill from her childhood home. See the head of this beloved Patron Saint of Italy on display in a gilded reliquary. Continue to the beautiful and elaborately decorated Duomo and Baptistery. Siena's Gothic Cathedral is full of treasures. The intricate floor mosaics, elaborate sculptures, and vivid frescoes were completed by the leading artists of the day. Independent lunch and free time to explore the Piazza del Campo (*Il Campo*). Return to Assisi. (B,D) Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Assisi.

DAY 5 <u>Monday, November 10: Orvieto | Rome</u> Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Assisi for Orvieto to visit Orvieto Cathedral, dedicated to the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, where the miraculous Corporal of Bolsena (Eucharistic Miracle of Orvieto) is housed. We'll have a guided tour of the magnificent 13th-century church with its marble exterior of alternating black and white stripes. In one of the side chapels are frescos by Luca Signorelli. Celebrate Mass at the Shrine. Independent lunch and free time to explore Orvieto on your own.

We'll continue to Rome, the "Eternal City." We'll see 2,500 years of history, from Roman ruins to 15th century churches, 17th century palaces, and 20th century monuments. Check-in at our hotel in Rome.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

## DAY 6 <u>Tuesday, November 11: Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica</u> Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (subject to confirmation) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass we will visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. End our morning

with a more detailed guided tour of St. Peter's Basilica. Take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. In your free time, you may wish to return to the Vatican Crypt to pray near the tomb of St. Peter. Independent lunch.

Free afternoon to explore the sights, sounds, and tastes of Rome all on your own! Perhaps you'll buy religious articles in preparation for the Papal Blessing at the audience on Wednesday. You may treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. Visit the Colosseum or the beautiful and lively Piazza Navona, with time to browse through the artists' stalls to buy a painting and sample one of Rome's most famous products, a tartufo at the Gelateria Tre Scalini. This is the time to visit the local shops and street vendors. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

### After early breakfast at our hotel, we will enter the heart of Christendom for an audience with our Holy Father. Pope Francis will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

Visit the Church of Santa Maria in Trestavere. In 38 BC, a fountain of oil flowed in Trestavere for an entire day. This miracle was a sign that Christ would spread his grace throughout the world. A sanctuary was built on the spot by Pope St. Calixtus. A basilica was built later, including a crypt that holds the remains of Calixtus and other saints. The present building, built in the 12th century, boasts elaborate mosaics depicting the prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah, Christ and the Blessed Virgin, and many popes and saints. An inscription marks the original site of the fons olei (fountain of oil). Celebrate Mass at the Church of Santa Maria. After Mass, free time will be given in Trastevere. Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

## DAY 8 Thursday, November 13: Ancient Rome | Papal Basilicas of Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our morning with a visit to the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome and the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum. See the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine and proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. Independent lunch.

The main distinction of the Papal Basilicas is that they each have a special "holy door" which are opened only during Jubilee years. Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. View relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem and the high altar, which contains the remains of St. Matthew the Evangelist. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, Protectress of the Roman People, believed to be painted by St. Luke. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there we'll pass by the Holy Stairs, said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. You can go up on your knees as thousands of pilgrims have done in reverently recalling the sufferings of Christ. Then, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

## DAY 9 Friday, November 14: Walking Tour of Historic Rome | Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls | Catacombs

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll go on a walking tour and experience the best of ancient Rome, beginning at the Pantheon. Built more than 1,800 years ago, the magnificent Pantheon still stands as a reminder of the great Roman Empire. The name Pantheon refers to the building's original function as a temple for the gods. When approaching the front of the Pantheon we can still see the original Latin dedication by Marcus Agrippa. Continue to the Church of San Luigi dei Francesi to see the stunning interior, which is home to a trio of Caravaggio masterpieces. Then we'll walk to the Trevi fountain and Piazza di Spagna, one of the most famous squares in Rome. See the Fontanna della Barcaccia (Fountain of the Old Boat) in the middle of the piazza and enjoy the view from the famous Spanish Steps. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, visit the magnificent Papal Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of St. Paul's tomb. After being totally destroyed by fire in 1823, it was rebuilt on the original basilican plan of early Christian churches. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each Pope, from Peter to Francis. Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls. After Mass, we'll continue along the Ancient Appian Way, seeing the huge slabs that originally paved its length and several surviving Patrician tombs, including the massive tomb of Cecilia Metella. Visit the Catacombs of St. Sebastian and the Basilica of St. Sebastian Outside-the-Walls. Walk through the maze of tunnels

where early Christians secretly practiced religious rites and buried their dead. Enjoy a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting with wine and music. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

## DAY 10 Saturday, November 15: Return from Rome

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. (B)

PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the wellbeing of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions. The insurance plan can be purchased at any time thereafter, excluding coverage for preexisting conditions, until final payment has been made. Plan payments will not be accepted after final payment has been made. All plan payments are non**refundable.** If you choose to extend your stay or plan a pre-tour program, travel insurance can be purchased for an additional \$4.00 per day. Additional coverage needs to be requested. The insurance plan will not automatically be extended. The insurance plan will only cover pre-paid arrangements made through PWT. Passengers who book their own airfare (Land Only passengers or those booking independent connecting flights) are advised to purchase travel insurance covering their flights directly from the airline or from another travel insurance supplier. The Passenger Travel Protection Plan includes coverage for the following: trip cancellation/ interruption/delay, accident/sickness medical expense, emergency medical evacuation /repatriation, lost baggage/personal effects, accidental death & dismemberment, and 24-hour Emergency Travel Assistance Services. Benefits and services are provided by Travel Insured International. Upon claim approval, reimbursement is up to 100% of the non-refundable payments for your trip. **The** Cancel For Any Reason (CFAR) add-on can be purchased for an additional cost (see pricing chart below). This includes reasons for cancellation not otherwise covered by the regular policy. You can cancel up to 2 days prior to departure and receive reimbursement of up to 80% of the non-refundable payments for your trip. Payment for CFAR must be included with your deposit at the time of enrollment. CFAR coverage cannot be purchased by New York State residents as per state law. Once you begin your trip, coverage under the plan will end as soon as you go back to your return destination. This means that if you return home early, your coverage will terminate early as well.
